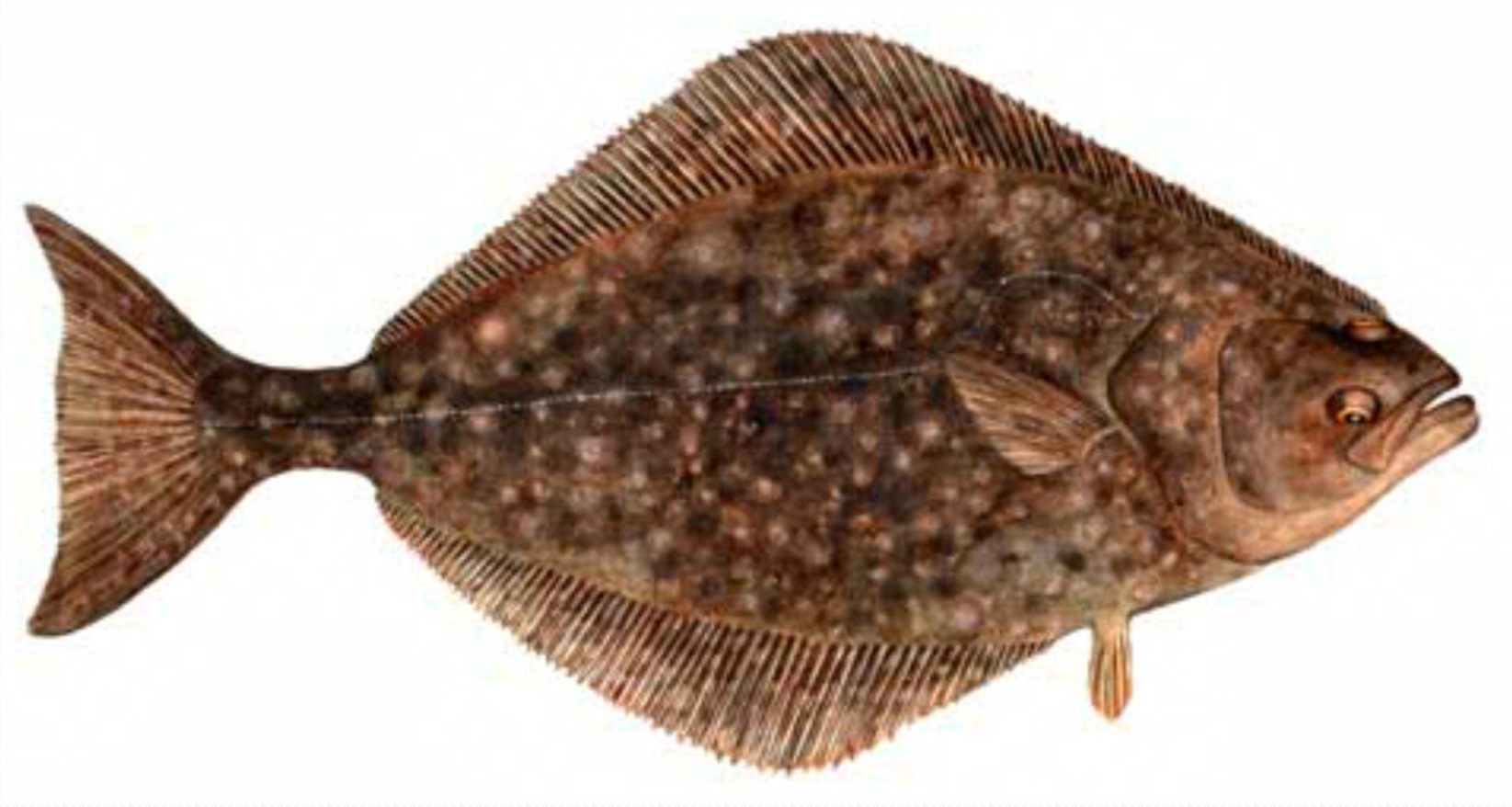

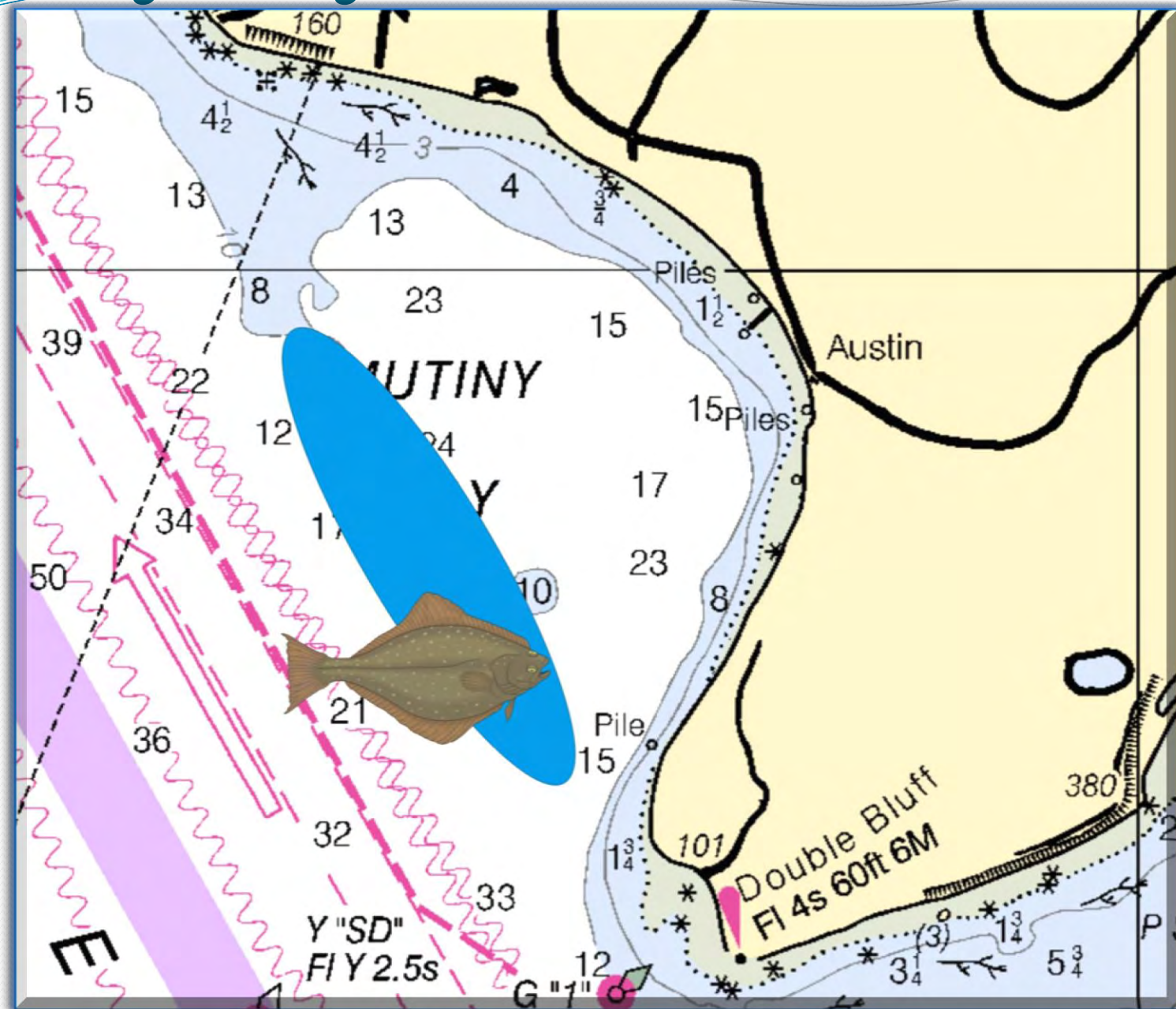

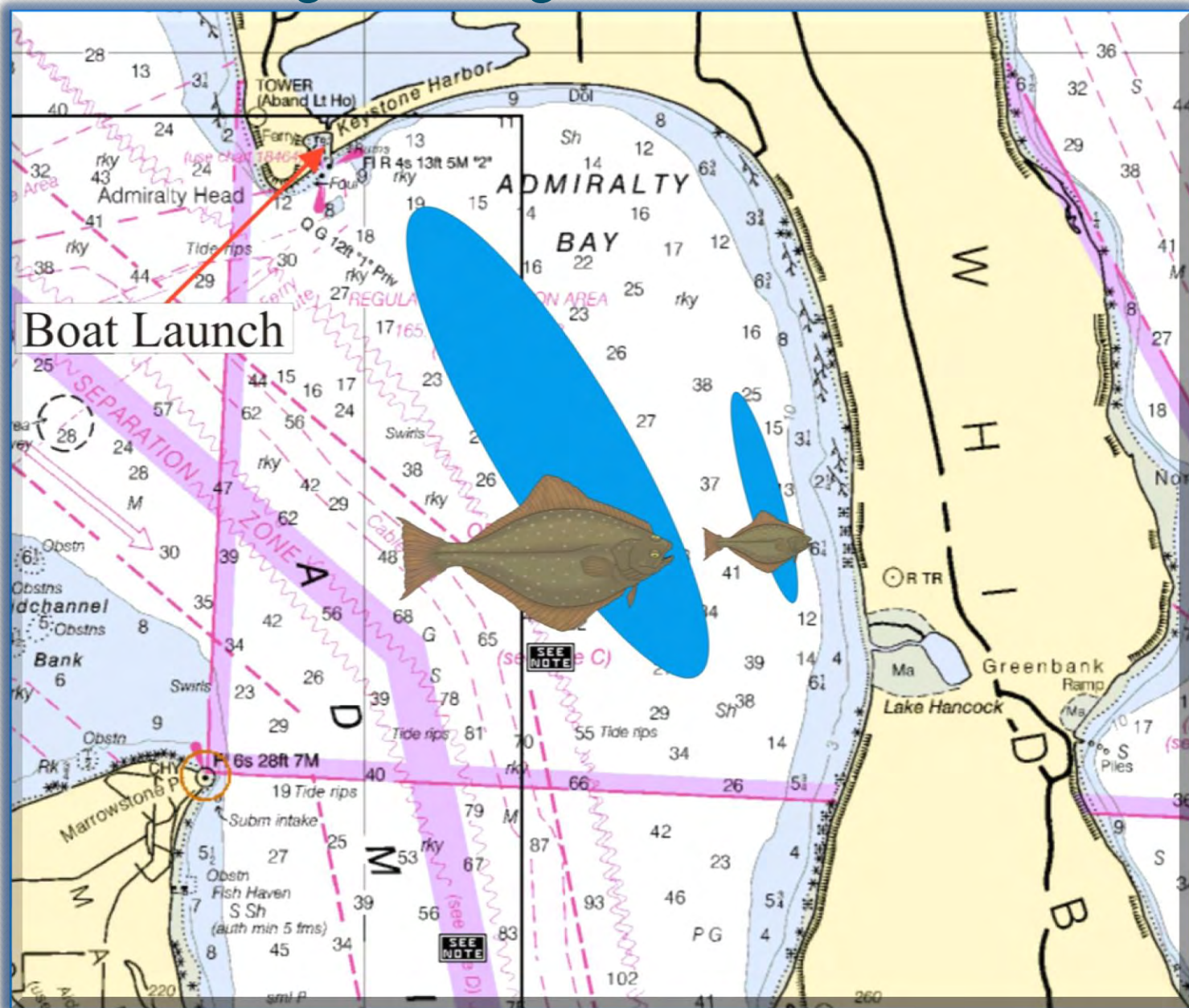
Effective Halibut Fishing

- Only Fish with High Percentage Gear
- Everyday Someone will Catch Fish on something that you do not have in your tackle box....**Tune It Out!**
This is usually a one time event
- Stay on the Bottom
- Keep your Rig Moving

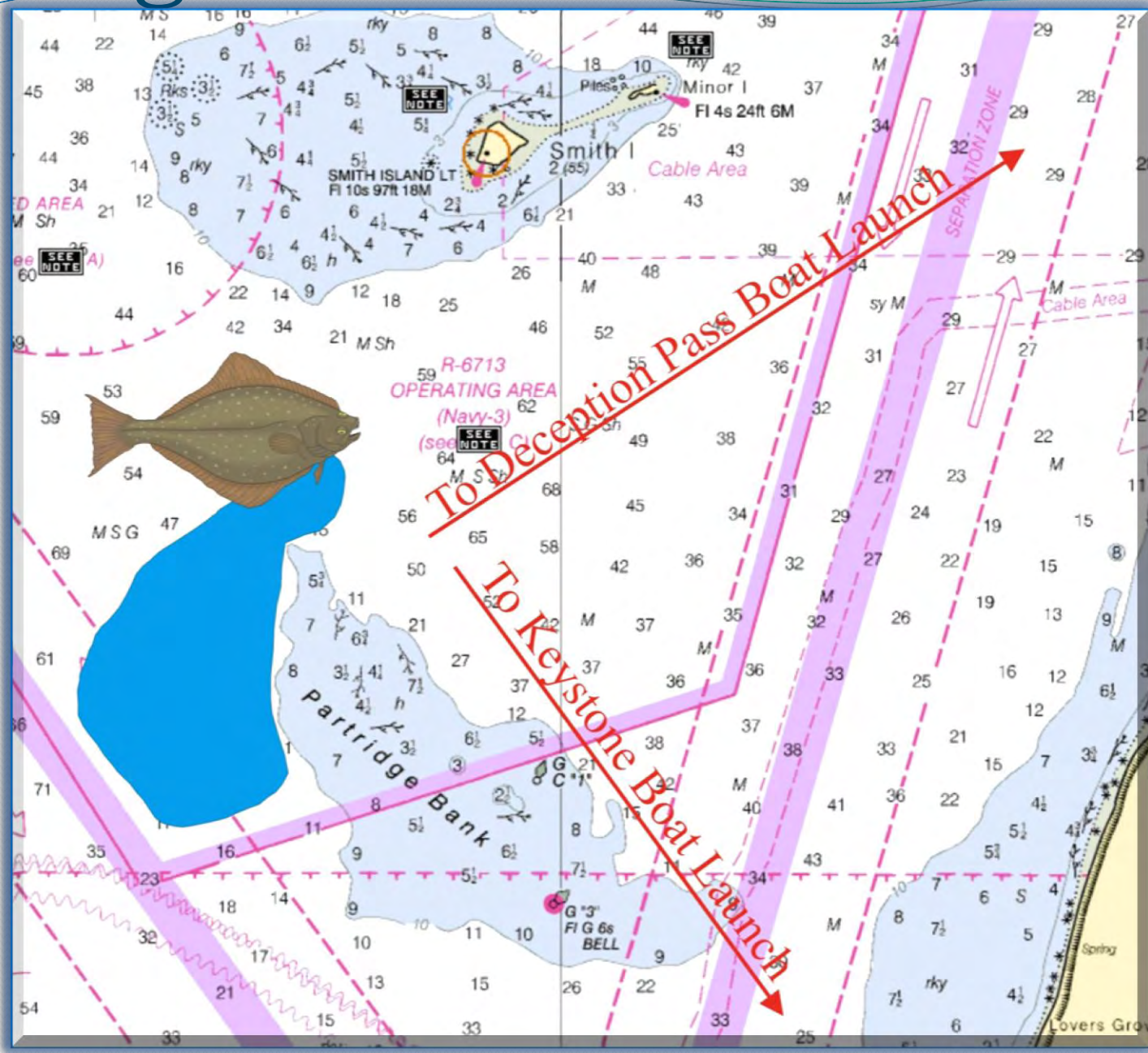

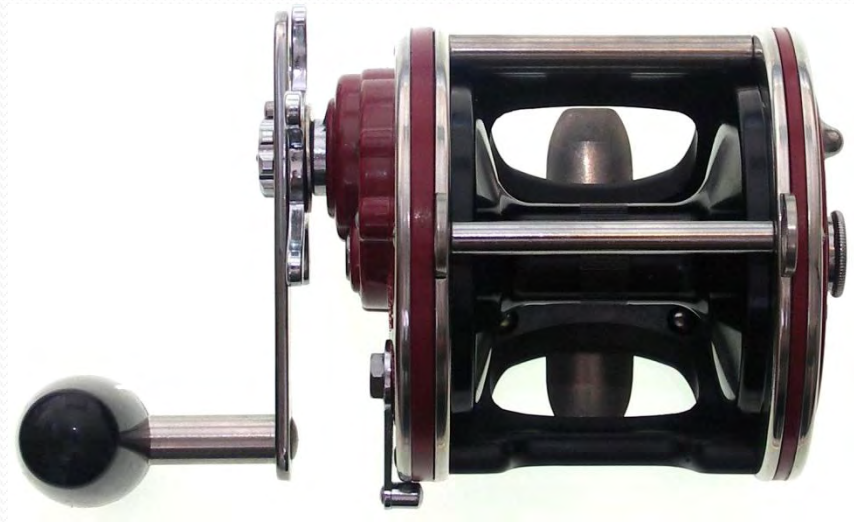
Halibut Depths

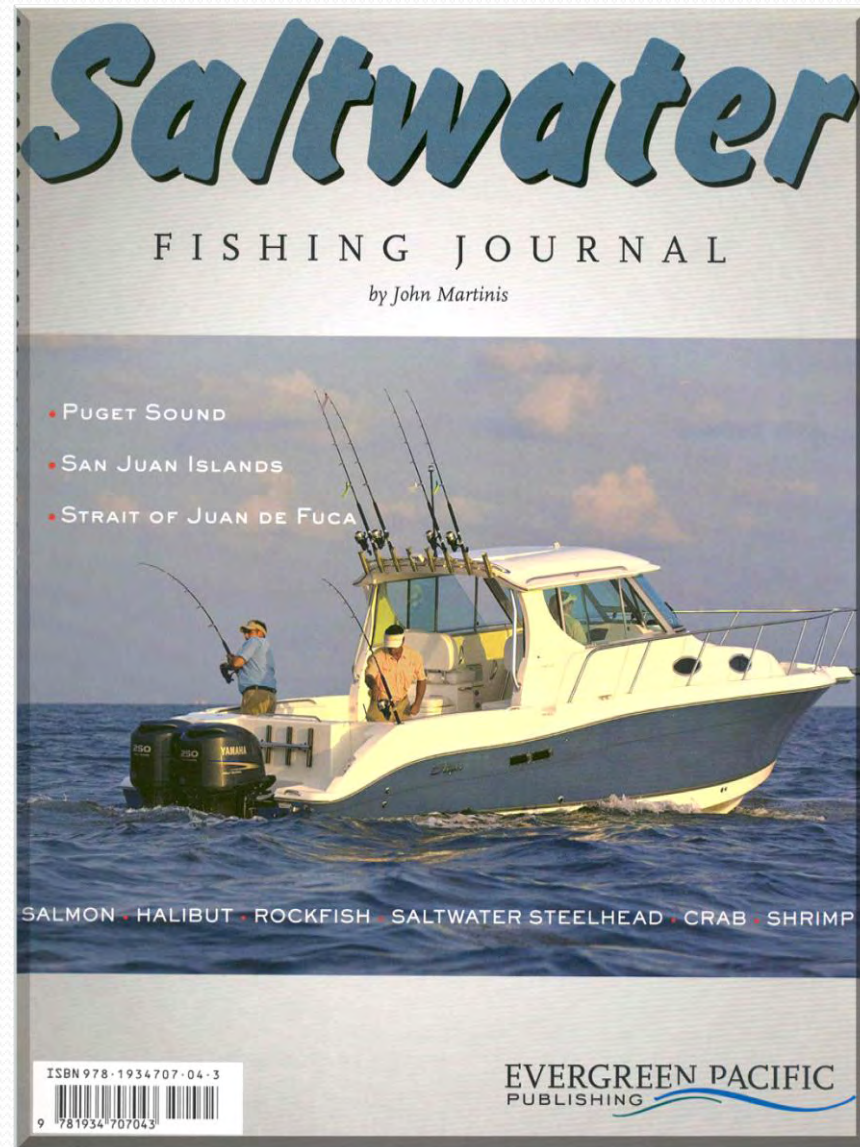
