Fishing Advice Callout:

If you want to catch large Blackmouth this is where you go. Yes, the weather has to be just right. Winds 10mph or less is ideal for winter fishing conditions. There is a ledge on the north side of Smith Island that runs parallel to the Island and westerly. To fish this correctly, stay in the usual 90-120 feet of water and fish very close to the bottom.
