
## Maps For The Serious Angler

## John's Sporting Goods

There are two ways to fish Hein Bank when the tide is going out, depending on the season. In the winter Chinook season I prefer to fish Hein Bank like any other contoured bar. Troll parallel to Hein Bank on the west side of the Bank. Stay in 90-120 feet of water and fish very close to the bottom. Troll with a Hot Spot flasher and a Goldstar 3.5 Red Racer spoon 42 inches behind the flasher. I would also consider trolling a Herring or an Anchovy 60" behind a Hot Spot flasher. Use a Rhys Davis Herring or Anchovy head holder for the bait.

In the Summer (July1-August 10) Chinook season I fish Hein Bank completely different. When the tide is going out, there a large rip that heads west off the Hein Bank buoy (The buoy that is in 30ft of water). I fish parallel to that rip. I start fishing along the rip in 180-200 feet of water and troll toward the buoy. As you head toward the buoy, you have to keep lifting your gear to accommodate the bottom coming up. Troll with a Hot Spot flasher and a Kingfisher 3.5 Red Racer spoon.
